LUCIDO BILLS PROTECT FAMILIES AND PETS

In many cases, where domestic violence occurs, animal abuse occurs too. According to the National Humane Society, 71% of domestic violence victims also report animal abuse by their abuser. That is why I have introduced legislation to require Child Protective Services (CPS) employees to make note and report observed or suspected abuse of pets.

Senate Bills 352 and 353 would require Child Protective Services employees to report any animal abuse they discover or suspect, throughout the course of a CPS investigation, to law enforcement or animal control officials. I am working on similar legislation that would extend this reporting requirement to veterinarians who believe a pet they are treating has been abused.

Michigan veterinarians are not currently required to report suspected animal abuse, even though they are perhaps the most qualified to spot it.

It is my hope that these changes will empower more people in positions to observe abuse, of any kind, to report it. This will result in earlier intervention and the protection of more innocent and vulnerable people and pets.

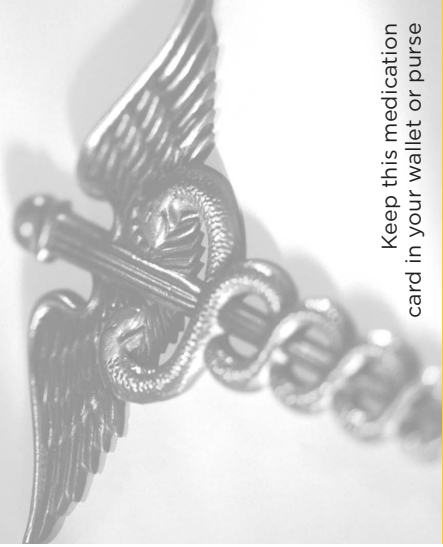
